



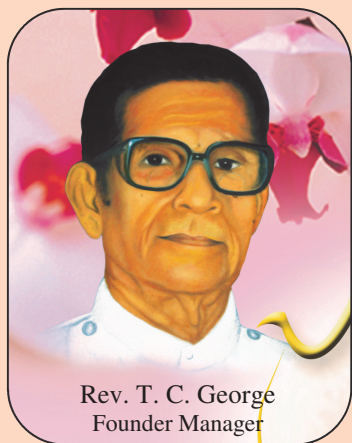

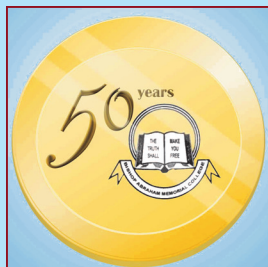

## Institutional News

### Rev. Dr. T. C. George Puraskaram and Memorial Lecture

'Rev. Dr. T. C. George Puraskaram' is an award instituted by Bishop Abraham Memorial Trust with a view to promote the vision and mission of the college and to perpetuate the memory of Rev. Dr. T. C. George, the Founder President and Manager of the college. He was a priest of spiritual wisdom, vision and compassion, who took up the mission of founding a higher education institution here in Thuruthicad in 1965 to empower the rural youth through value-based integral education. He served and guided the college until his death in 1999. The management of the college instituted an award in the name of the great visionary in 2006. The award is given to an educationalist, educational institution or teacher in Kerala for contributions in the rural area. Priority is given to those who promote or impart value-based education, and merit is also given for additional qualifications and contributions.

This year, a judging panel under the chairmanship of Dr. Alexander Karrackal (Former Vice-Chancellor, Kannur University) scrutinised and evaluated the entries for the Puraskaram. Prof. O. A. Cherian (Former Principal, St. Thomas College, Kozhanchery) and Dr. Jose Parakkadavil (Former Principal, B A M college, Thuruthicad) served as panel members.

The panel selected C. M. S. L P School Mundakkayam and remarked that the school is practicing many innovative programmes which are student friendly, community oriented as well as eco-centric. The highlight of the activities of the school is the programme "From School to Home".

On 29<sup>th</sup> January, Mr. Rejimon Cherian, Headmaster of C M S L P School, received the Puraskaram from Prof. P. J. Kurian (Deputy Chairman Rajya Sabha) in the presence of other dignitaries, staff and students at College Chapel. Prof. P. J. 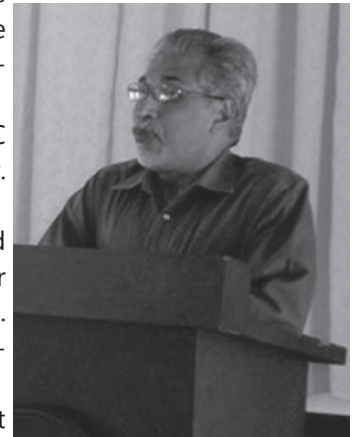

## Departmental Activities

### Darshan 2014

The memory of C. V. Raman, a renowned Indian physicist who discovered Raman Effect in 1928 is commemorated on 28th February as National Science Day. As part of this year's National Science Day Celebrations, the Department of Physics and the Department of Zoology jointly organised an exhibition, Darshan 2014. It was an effort to popularize basic science and alternate energy resources among the society. The central theme of the programme was 'Fostering Scientific Temper'.

The exhibition provided an opportunity for students to understand various basic theories in science through experiments. Numerous preserved specimens, living organisms, models of different types of ecosystem, models of internal organs etc. were on display. Methods for utilising solar energy for domestic purposes, scientific waste management, apiculture and fish farming etc. were explained to the public through models and demonstrations prepared by the students of the organising departments.

'Dark House' attracted the attention of all the visitors. The puzzle section and demonstrations of science behind various magic tricks arouse interest in school students. A collection of postal stamps released to commemorate various personalities in science and events of scientific importance were showcased.

A seminar on 'Space Explorations and a Journey to Mars' was also organised along with the exhibition. Ens Mathews (Department of Physics) was the resource person. Different types of space missions and the details of India's dream mission to explore Mars were discussed. A documentary on solar system was also screened. The evolution of communication technology during last few decades were also demonstrated by displaying both old and modern communication and data storage equipments.

The exhibition was inaugurated by Prof. Thomas Abraham (Manager) and the principal Dr. Mathews M. George delivered the key-note address. 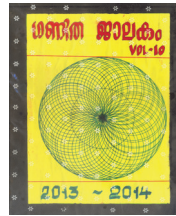

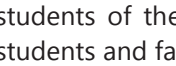
### Managing the Future

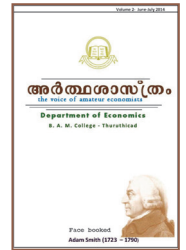


### Ganithajalagam
