Student Feedback on Teachers

Bishop Abraham Memorial College, Thuruthicad has implemented a closed loop system which corrects itself through the feedbacks/surveys. Students' responses to teaching, problems faced in the conduct of classes and examinations and internal examination results are also discussed and reviewed very carefully. IQAC collects feedback on teaching-learning processes. Responses of students' feedback is analyzed with the help of Student Support Cell. The review has helped to make suitable changes in academic plan and teaching plan, arrange special classes, modify teaching-learning practices, take steps in advance to overcome hindrances during the course of academic activities and ensure systematic teaching-learning.

METHOD


To assess the teachers' performance, a pre-validated and anonymous questionnaire circulated among students through online form during the month of May 2021. All students enrolled during 2018 - 2021 participated in the survey. Participation was voluntary and respondents were ensured confidentiality. The questionnaire had closed ended questions and students were asked to rate the performance of their teachers on 12 parameters, on a five-point scale. They were also free to give their suggestions and opinion in the space provided for remarks. Description of ratings is as follows:

1 - Strongly Disagree, 2 - Disagree, 3 - Satisfactory, 4 - Agree, 5 - Strongly Agree By using these rating points average score obtained for each question is calculated separately. Teaching - learning process and its supporting infrastructural requirements as well as competency of teachers are different in different disciplines. Therefore, analysis is done separately in three streams viz. Arts, Commerce and Science.

QUESTIONS ASKED

- 1. The teacher provides guidance/counselling in academic and non-academic matters in/outside the class.
- 2. The teacher encourages participation and discussion in class.
- 3. The teacher uses modern teaching aids/gadgets, handouts, suggestion of references, ppts, web resources, etc.
- 4. The teacher pays attention to academically weaker students as well.
- 5. The teacher is regular and punctual in class.
- 6. The teacher invites opinion and questions on subject matter from students.
- 7. The teacher inspires students for ethical conduct
- 8. The teacher links the subject to real life experiences and creates interest in the subject.
- 9. The teacher covers the entire syllabus in time.
- 10. The teacher explains the topics efficiently.
- 11. Periodical assessments are conducted as per schedule.
- 12. The teacher uses non-traditional methods of evaluation like quiz, seminars, assignments, classroom presentations/ participation (or any other method)

Student Feedback on College (Overall)


METHOD

METHOD



QUESTIONS ASKED




Criteria-wise Overall Rating




Programme-wise Feedback on Curriculum
